- WSC Q&A 12-14

- Q.12 What special act of providence did God exercise towards man in the estate wherein he was created?
- A. When God had created man, he entered into a covenant of life with him, upon condition of perfect obedience; forbidding him to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, upon pain of death.
- Q.13 Did our first parents continue in the estate wherein they were created?
- A. Our first parents, being left to the freedom of their own will, fell from the estate wherein they were created, by sinning against God.
- Q.14 What is sin?
- A. Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, the law of God.
