— WSC Q&A 16-17, 20

Q.16 Did all mankind fall in Adam's first transgression?

- A. The covenant being made with Adam, not only for himself, but for his posterity; all mankind, descending from him by ordinary generation, sinned in him, and fell with him, in his first transgression.
- Q.17 Into what estate did the fall bring mankind?
- A. The fall brought mankind into an estate of sin and misery.
- Q.20 Did God leave all mankind to perish in the estate of sin and misery?
- A. God, having, out of his mere good pleasure, from all eternity, elected some to everlasting life, did enter into a covenant of grace, to deliver them out of the estate of sin and misery, and to bring them into an estate of salvation by a Redeemer.
